The books and accounts of the Fish Market and Centre for the two years ended 31st December, 1961, and 31st December, 1962, have been examined under my direction.

# TRADING AND PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT - 1961 Operation of Market Services

#### Miscellaneous Expenses - \$1,849.08

2. As the result of an error of commission, the total miscellaneous expenses for the year have been over-stated by \$20.00.

#### Net Loss - \$8,883.65

3. As the result of the comment at paragraph 2, above, the net loss for the year has been over-stated by \$20.00.

#### BALANCE SHEET AS AT 31ST DECEMBER, 1961

#### (a) Assets

### Government Produce Depot, Georgetown \$2.184.49

4. The balance, due to the Fish Market and Centre, as reflected in the books of the Government Produce Depot at 31st December, 1961, was \$2,180.57, a difference of \$3.92.

5. The balance due to the Fish Market and Centre as reflected in the books of the Milk Pasteurisation Plant at 31st December, 1961, was \$346.80, a difference of \$139.22.

#### (b) Liabilities

# Accountant General Current Account - \$8,103.84

- 6. As a result of the comment at paragraph 3, above, this balance has been over-stated by \$20.00.
- 7. The balance of the deposit account as shown in the books of the Accountant General at 31st December, 1961, was \$14,130.52. It has been suggested that steps should be taken to reconcile and adjust the difference of \$6,026.68.

### Sundry Creditors - Open Accounts - \$9,521.31

S. As a result of the error of commission mentioned at paragraph 2, above, this total has been over-stated by \$20.00.

#### TRADING AND PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT - 1962

# Sales - \$341,704.78

9. Errors in calculating the selling price of fish have resulted in several incorrect charges to customers' accounts and a net under-statement of \$49.28, in the total sales for the year.

#### Net Loss - \$40,619.90

10. As a result of the comment at paragraph 9, above, the net loss for the year has been over-stated by \$\frac{4}{9}.28\$.

#### BALANCE SHEET AS AT 31ST DECEMBER, 1962

### (a) Assets

### Sundry Debtors - Open Accounts - \$26,179.13

- 11. As the result of the incorrect charges to customers' accounts, mentioned at paragraph 9, above, this total has been under-stated by a net amount of \$49.28.
- 12. Information has been requested concerning the action taken to effect recovery of sundry debtors' balances totalling \$13,511.42, which have remained outstanding for a considerable period.
- 13. Attention has also been drawn to the position regarding balances due by fish centres and fish vendors. It would appear that there has been very unsatisfactory credit control and, as a result, large balances, far in excess of the approved limit of one week's credit, have been permitted to accumulate.

14. It has been suggested that action should be taken to clear credit balances on debtors' accounts totalling \$1,198.56, at 31st December, 1962.

Milk Pasteurisation Plant - Open Accounts

Milk Pasteurisation Plant - General Ledger Account - 32.13

\$4,313.80

15. The balance due to the Fish Market and Centre, as reflected in the books of the Milk Pasteurisation Plant at 31st December, 1962, was \$3,808.61. It has been suggested that steps should be taken to reconcile and adjust this difference of \$537.32.

#### Deposit on Ammonia Cylinders - \$1,036.80

16. It would appear that the cylinders, in respect of which this deposit had been paid, had all been returned during 1962, but the deposit remained unrecovered up to the time of inspection in August, 1963. This is unsatisfactory.

#### (b) Liabilities

### Accountant General Current Account - \$44,839.46

- 17. As a result of the comments at paragraphs 6, and 10, above, this balance has been over-stated by \$69.28.
- 18. It has not been possible to verify this balance with the balance of the Treasury Deposit Account, as at the time of inspection in August, 1963, the books of the Accountant General had not yet been closed to 31st December, 1962.

### Sundry Creditors - Open Accounts - \$20,945.30

- 19. As a result of the comment at paragraph 7, above, this balance has been over-stated by \$20.00.
- 20. This balance includes an amount of \$183.52, which has remained unpaid since 1960. It has been suggested that steps should be taken to clear this account.

#### GENERAL

#### Stock

21. Stock lists, duly certified by an employee of the Fish Market and Centre, have been produced in support of the stocks on hand at 31st December, 1961, and 31st December, 1962. Attention has been drawn to the fact that a physical check of these stocks by a Board of Survey, has however, not been carried out.

- 22. Attention has been drawn to the writes off of abnormal losses resulting from spoilage and shrinkage.
- 23. It was claimed that 24,247 pounds of fish, valued at approximately \$8,392.78, had been condemned as being unfit for human consumption on the recommendation of the I.C.A. Fisheries Adviser during the quarter ended 30th September, 1961, and accordingly written off. It would appear, however, that this officer did not agree that this quantity of fish had been disposed of due to spoilage during a three months period. He further denied that he had been advised of this loss and suggested that the matter warranted an investigation. Information has been requested as to what further action, if any, was taken in the matter.
- 24. Certificates from the Municipal Incinerator have not been seen confirming the destruction of 87,873 pounds of fish which had been written off due to spoilage during 1962 and which, it was claimed, had been sent to the Incinerator for destruction.
- 25. Shortages of stock which are revealed by a physical check are written off as shrinkage without, it would appear, any investigation being carried out as to the causes for such large discrepancies. It follows that any shortages which may have resulted from theft, fraud or clerical errors are automatically written off.
- 26. It was brought to attention in our 1960 report that the writing off of spoilages and shrinkages was not done in accordance with the approved procedure. On 7th June, 1961, the Director of Marketing gave an assurance that strict compliance with the procedure would, in future, be insisted upon. However, during the period under review no evidence has been seen that the correct procedure has been implemented.
- 27. The spoilages and shrinkages in this Market are reaching alarming proportions. I am not satisfied that there is sufficient control over the physical stock nor is sufficient investigation into these shortages being carried out and as a result it is not possible to determine if they have resulted from theft, fraud, or serious irregularity.
- 28. The stock books, as produced for inspection, do not bear any evidence of internal check.

#### Yearly Deficits

29. Over the last five years, the net deficits, for the running of the Fish Market and Centre, were as follows:-

30. The increased deficit for the year 1962, should give cause for grave concern as such deficits are a charge against Public Funds.
