Mrs. Whittaker former Assistant Housekeeper of the Government Training College was assigned the duties of Housekeeper with effect from 1st September, 1959, at a fixed higher rate of salary, but was not formally appointed to the post before her retrenchment in January 1963, consequent on the abolition of the post. Mrs. Whittaker in accordance with the Superanmuation provisions may only be given a gratuity on the basis of the salary of her substantive appointment as 'Assistant Housekeeper'. However, in view of the fact that she was assigned and performed the duties of Housekeeper since 1959 at a flat salary, it is felt that even though she was not formally appointed to the post she should be paid a gratuity on the basis of the total emoluments she drew at the time of her retrench-The additional provision is necessary to provide for an 'ex gratia' payment of \$558.45 to Mrs. Whittaker representing the difference between the amount she would have drawn had she been formally appointed to the post of 'Housekeeper' and the amount she actually drew.
