BREACHES OF LICENSING LAWS

8. Departmental vigilance to prevent evasion was maintained during the year and 2,537 cases of breaches of Licensing Laws as against 1,336 in 1961 were detected. The option provided by section 11 of the Miscellaneous Licences Ordinance was exercised in 2,387 cases and departmental fines in the sum of \$5,139 were imposed. In 154 cases, where the unpaid licence duty exceeded \$50: or defaulters did not avail themselves of the option of being dealt with departmentally summonses, were issued. Fines inflicted by Magistrates amounted to \$2,027.
