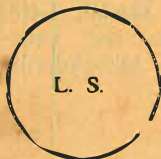

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir RICHARD EDMONDS LUYT, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, upon whom has been conferred the Distinguished Conduct Medal, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of British Guiana, Vice-Admiral of the same,

WHEREAS article 14 of the Constitution of British Guiana applies to any period when there is in force a proclamation made by the Governor and published in the Gazette declaring that a state of public emergency exists for the purposes of the said article;

AND WHEREAS I am satisfied that a state of public emergency exists for the purposes of the said article:

NOW THEREFORE acting in accordance with paragraph (1) of article 22 of the Constitution of British Guiana I do hereby declare that a state of public emergency exists for the purposes of article 14 of the said Constitution.

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of the Colony, at Government House, British Guiana, this 22nd day of May, 1964, and in the thirteenth year of Her Majesty's reign.
