THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1962.
- 2. The Trade Classification List and Tariff of Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the increase of the rates of import duty on the items set out in Part A of the schedule hereto to the extent specified therein.
- 3. The second proviso to the Trade Classification List and Tariff of Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the insertion of the articles set out in Part B of the schedule hereto at the rate of import duty specified therein.
