Citation.

 These Regulations may be cited as the Maritime Zones (Internal Waters and River Closing Baselines) Regulations 2015.

Coordinates.

- 2. The geodetic coordinates of the points of the straight baselines which close the mouths of the Essequibo, Demerara and Berbice Rivers, are-
 - (a) based on the World Geodetic System 1984 (WGS84) datum; and

(b) specified in the Schedule.

Basclines.

3. The baselines specified in the Schedule in regulation 2 constitute the outer limits of the internal waters of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana at the mouths of the Essequibo, Demerara and Berbice Rivers.
