### THE MARITIME ZONES ACT

(Cap. 63: 01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9 OF THE MARITIME ZONES ACT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 9 OF THE UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON THE LAW OF THE SEA 1982, AND AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR LANDS AND SURVEYS, I MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

| Citation.    | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Maritime Zones (Internal Waters and River Closing Baselines) Regulations 2015.  |
| Coordinates. | 2. The geodetic coordinates of the points of the straight baselines which close the mouths of the Essequibo, Demerara and Berbice Rivers, are-<br>(a) based on the World Geodetic System 1984 (WGS84) datum; and<br>(b) specified in the Schedule. |
| Schedule.    |  |
| Baselines.   | 3. The baselines specified in the Schedule in regulation 2 constitute the outer limits of the internal waters of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana at the mouths of the Essequibo, Demerara and Berbice Rivers.                                   |
