SUMMARY

The Inland Revenue Department's performance in 1981 was very good despite set backs caused by inadequate staff. The total number of vacancies as at 31st December, 1981, was 94. The computers are still not functioning properly and this is further aggravated by the lack of a constant supply of electricity. The Revenue Collection in 1981 was \$249.6 (M) against \$216.3 (M) in 1980 an increase of 33.3 (M) over 1980. This is an excess of \$16.3 (M) over the revised budgeted collections of \$233.3 (M).

The average work force was 275 or 74.5% of the establishment of 369. Request was made to the Public Service Commission to fill existing vacancies and it is hoped that 53 of these will be filled in 1982. In spite of the inflationary trend the Department was able to hold its cost of Administration at \$2.6 (M) which is 1.04 percent of the gross revenue collected.

ORGANISATION STRUCTURE AND MANAGEMENT

The Department is administered by a Commissioner of Inland Revenue assisted by a Deputy and three Assistant Lommissioners who are directly responsible for the day to day administration of the Companies, Collections and Administrative Divisions organised as set in the Chart at Appendix "A". The Licence Revenue and Estate Duty Divisions are headed by a Licence Revenue Officer and a Senior Inspector of Taxes respectively.

LOCATION OF OFFICES

The Department's offices are located as follows:-

- (1) <u>HEAD OFFICE</u> <u>LAMAHA & EAST STREETS, GEORGETOWN</u> This houses the office of the Commissioner of Inland Revenue. The other Divisions located here are the Companies, Field Audit and Investigation, Entertainment Duty, Personnel and Legal.
- (2) <u>GENERAL OFFICE</u> <u>G.P.O. BUILDING, GEORGETOWN</u> This office houses the Deputy Commissioner, the Collections and Electronic Data Processing Unit, Estate Duty and Administrative Divisions, also the Registry, Sole Traders (Self-Employed), P.A.Y.E. and
 - Tax Exit Units.
- (3) BOARD OF REVIEW CAMP STREET, GEORGETOWN

This office houses the two Boards of Review. A Senior Inspector of Taxes is in charge who is assisted by other staff in the preparation of appeal cases for hearing.

(4) <u>LICENCE REVENUE OFFICE</u> - <u>SMYTH & PRINCESS STREETS</u>

This office houses the Licence Revenue Officer and his staff charged with the direct administration of the Division. There is a branch in New Amsterdam charged with the responsibility of collecting the tolls on the Corentyne Highway.

(5) NEW AMSTERDAM - VRYMAN'S ERVEN

This office is headed by a Senior Inspector of Taxes, and renders service to taxpayers resident from Abary River on the West Coast of Berbice, New Amsterdam, Berbice River, and to Whim on the Corentyne Coast.

- (6) <u>CDERIVERTON OFFICE</u> This office is headed by an Inspector of Taxes and provides service to residents on the Upper Corentyne including Black Bush Polder, and the Corentyne River.
- (7) <u>LINDEN</u> This office is headed by an Inspector of Taxes and caters for residents in the Mining Town of Linden/Wismar and Upper Demorara River.

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
NEW LEGISLATION

Changes made in the Tax Legislation for 1981 were as follows:-


- (a) Order No. 26 of 1981 amended the Travel Voucher Tax payable on Airline Tickets from 20% to 30%.
- (b) Regulation No. 2 of 1981 increased the Travel Tax from \$10.00 to \$25.00.
- (c) The Tax Bands in respect of Personal Income Tax were revised.
- (d) Regulations No. 4 of 1981 made under the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (Chapter 51:02) increased the Licences fees for Motor Vehicles.
- (e) Regulations No. 5 of 1981 made under the Roads Act, (Chapter 51:01) increased the Tolls payable on the Soesdyke/ Linden Highway.
- (f) Regulations No. 7 of 1981 made under the Roads Act, (Chapter 51:01) increased the tolls payable on the Corentyne Highway.
- (g) Act No. 7 of 1981 increased the Licences paid by Business places etc.

TAX COLLECTED

Gross Revenue Collected by the Department increased from \$216.3(M) in 1980 to \$249.6(M) an increase of 33.3(M).

INCOME AND CORPORATION TAXES

REFUNDS AND NET COLLECTIONS

During the year 1981 refunds of taxes totalling \$2.9 (M) were paid and when subtracted from Gross Collections of \$249.6 (M) total net collections of \$246.7(M) was realised.

TAX ASSESSED

Tax assessed in 1981 totalled \$102 (M) as against \$125.9(M) in 1980. Table II shows the breakdown of tax assessed in 1980 and 1981.

OBJECTIONS AND APPEALS

Taxpayers continued to exercise the right to object to assessments, conferred by Section 78(2) of the Income Tax Act, Chapter 81:01. The objections lodged centred around:

- (1) Disputes over the interpretation of the Tax Law.
- (2) Disputes over the admissibility of particular items of expenditure deemed deductable in computing chargeable income.

In 1981 there were 1213 objections registered as against 1139 in 1980. The Table below shows the picture as regards objections.

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FIELD AUDIT AND INVESTIGATIONS

This unit as previously stated is supervised by the Assistant Commissioner of Inland Revenue (Companies) who is accountable to the Commissioner of Inland Revenue. On the basis of investigations carried out and Third Party information supplied a number of taxpayer's Tax Returns have been thoroughly examined. It is expected that the Department should collect substantial additional taxes.

During the year the P.A.Y.E. Inspectors attached to this unit carried out a campaign and it was discovered that certain Private Sector Companies and Public Sector Corporations have been making incorrect tax deductions under P.A.Y.E. system from employees wages and salaries.

Two Public Sector Corporations have been making P.A.Y.E. deductions from employees emcluments and not paying in the amounts to the Inland Revenue Department. The amount involved is about two million dollars (\$2.M). The work of this unit has been hampered by the lack of staff. In spite of the various constraints some measure of success was achieved as shown in TABLE V.

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ESTATE DUTY

A Senior Inspector of Taxes continued to function as Proper Officer under the Estate Duty Act. In addition he had the responsibility for the examination of Pension Schemes, and Decds of Covenant submitted for approval. Estate Duty collected and the number of Declarations made are shown below:

LICENCE REVENUE DIVISION

This division administered the collection of Motor Vehicle, and other licences, duties road toll fees, and purchase tax on cars. Gross Revenue Collections from various licences/duties and comparison of actual collections relative to budgeted figures are shown at Tables VII and XI respectively. Gross collections in 1981 was \$12.3 (M) against \$9.4 (M) in 1980.

NEW VEHICLES REGISTERED AND VEHICLES IN OPERATION IN 1981

In 1981 there were 2157 new registration of vchicles against 1,804 in 1980, a net increase of 353. Vehicles in operation in 1981 amounted to 70,324 against 69,356 in 1980, a net increase of 968. Table XII set out the various categories of new vehicles registered and vehicles in operation in 1980 and 1981.

COST OF ADMINISTERING THE DEPARTMENT

The cost of running the Department in 1981 totalled #2,657,552. representing 1.04% of gross revenue collected. Details of the cost of collections is shown at Table XIII.

COMPUTERIZATION AND TAX ADMINISTRATION

The IBM Computer continued in 1981 as in 1980 to be manned by the Data Processing Unit of the Public Service Ministry. There continued to be some improvement in the processing of assessments, but problems are still being experienced in terms of programming and other technical difficulties. The Department was promised by the Data Processing Unit to have ready in 1981 the programmes to collect statistical Data for Administrative purposes. At the time of writing this report these programmes are not yet completed. Load shedding by the Guyana Electricity Corporation continue to interfere with the work of the Department.

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
