INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

Presentation and First Reading

TRADE (AMENDMENT) BILL 1975 - Bill No. 13/1975 published 22.3.75

The Minister of Trade and Consumer Protection, on behalf of the Government presented the following Bill which was read the first time:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE TRADE ACT.

The Minister of Finance moved the following motion:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly in accordance with section 5A of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chapter 51:02, confirm the Purchase Tax (Motor Cars) (Amendment) Order 1975 (No.23), which was made on the 1st of March, 1975, and published in the Gazette on the 3rd of March, 1975.

The Leader of the Opposition spoke to the motion.

Thereafter, the Minister of Finance replied.

The motion was then put and carried.

BILLS Second and Third Readings

Item 2 KURU KURU CO-OPERATIVE COLLEGE BILL 1975 - Bill No. 11/1975 published 5.3.75

The Minister of Co-operatives and National Mobilisation moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE KURU KURU CO-OPERATIVE COLLEGE AND FOR MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH.

Mrs. Da Silva spoke to the motion.

Thereafter, the Minister of Co-operatives and National Mobilisation replied.

The motion was then put and carried.

The Bill was read a second time.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

In Committee

Clauses 1 to 12 were passed as printed.

<u>Clause 13:</u> The following amendment by the Leader of the Opposition was put and <u>carried:</u>

Sugetitution of the following for subsection (2):

"(2) The Minister shall, as soon as practicable after the submission to him of the aforesaid reports and statement of accounts, cause a copy thereof to be laid before the National Assembly.".

Clause 13 was then passed as amended.

Clause 14 was passed as printed.

<u>Clause 15:</u> The following amendment by the Minister of Co-operatives and National Mobilisation was put and <u>carried:</u>

Clause 15 was then rassed as amended.

Clauses16 and 17 were passed as printed.

The Schedule was passed as printed.

Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Minister of Co-operatives and National Mobilisation, the Cill was reed the third third time and passed as amended in Committee.
