QUESTION TO MINISTERS

Question No. 19

<u>Cde. Ally</u> asked the Minister of Economic Development and Co-operatives the following question:

QUESTION: Will the Minister of Economic Development and Co-operatives say why the kokers of No. 47 and No. 48 main trench, Corentyne, have been allowed to be in a state of disrepair for years, so much so that salt.

water now affects the last remaining part of the rice cultivation of the two villages?

The Minister of Economic Development and Co-operatives gave the following reply:

ANSWER:

It is a fact that the koker in the No. 47/48 main trench is defective. Several efforts were made from time to time to repair it but these have proved unsuccessful because of the nature of the problem.

However, the area never suffered from salt water seeping to such an extent as to affect the cultivation areas, as alleged. In fact, the trench was "blinded" by a stop-off in 1976 and has been maintained and regulated to prevent the passage of salt water into the cultivation areas.

The Ministry of Economic Development and Co-operatives made a loan of \$8,000 to the No. 51/Good Hope Village District to help to construct a new koker, the estimated cost of which is \$9,000. The Council is providing the sum of \$1,000 from its own resources, and I am happy to inform this House that work has already begun on the repairing of the koker.

MOTION

ITEM 1 - GUARANTEE OF LOAN TO GUYANA RICE BOARD

The Minister of Finance moved the following motion:

WHEREAS the Guyana Rice Board, a Public Corporation, requires overdraft facilities of approximately twenty-eight million Guyana dollars(G\$28,000,000);

AND WHEREAS the Royal Bank of Canada, Barclays Bank International Limited and the Guyana National Co-operative Bank, lending agencies within the meaning of the State Enterprises (Guarantee) Act, Chapter 77:03, are willing to provide the said sum of money on a guarantee given by the Government of Guyana:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly do hereby authorise the Minister of Finance, or such other person duly authorised by him, acting on behalf of the Government of Guyana, to enter into agreements as guarantor for the Public Corporation with the abovementioned lending agencies (including the authority to sign any promissory notes or other related documents in pursuance of the said agreements) for the purpose of guaranteeing the said sum of approximately twenty-eight million Guyana dollars (G\$28,000,000) in accordance with the State Enterprises (Guarantee) Act, Chapter 77:03.
