#### BILLS - Second and Third Readings

# PUBLIC CORPORATIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL 1972 - Bill No. 10/1972 published 15,11,72

The Minister of Mines and Forests, on behalf of the Prime Minister, moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE 1962.

<u>Substitution</u> of "(c) for "(e)" in the first **line** of paragraph (a).

- <u>Clause 3</u> The following amendments by the Minister of Mines and Forests were put and <u>carried</u>:
  - (i) <u>Substitution</u> of the word "any" for the word "and" immediately before the word "shares" in the third line;
  - (ii) <u>Insertion</u> of the words "where it appears for the second time" immediately before the word "and" in the fifth line;

Clause 3 was then passed as amended.

### Assembly regumed.

On a motion by the Minister of Mines and Forests the Bill was read the third time and  $\underline{\text{passed}}$  as  $\underline{\text{amended}}$  in Committee.

# SUGAR INDUSTRY SPECIAL FUNDS (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) BILL 1972 - Bill No. 11/1972 published 15.11.72
