The Committee considered Appendix A to the Transport and Harbours Estimates and at the request of the Minister of Communications and Works recommended:

- (i) the insertion of a new item, viz. 17 Replacement of one (1) Steel Pontoon\$45,000:-; and
- (ii) the reduction by \$17,000 (i.e., from \$275,000 to \$258,000) on item (6), Maintenance and Repairs.

Items (17) to (46) of the printed Draft Estimates were re-numbered as items (18) to (47).

HEAD 49 - TRANSPORT AND HARBOURS was accordingly increased by \$28,000:- and passed at \$1,885,762:-

HEAD XIV - TRANSPORT AND HARBOURS (DEVELOPMENT) - passed as printed - \$2,158,998
