**THE RICE (REGULATION OF MANUFACTURING AND
MARKETING) ACT 1985**

(Act No. 1 of 1985)

IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 57 OF THE RICE (REGULATION OF MANUFACTURING AND MARKETING) ACT 1985, THE GUYANA RICE MILLING AND MARKETING AUTHORITY HEREBY GIVES NOTICE AS FOLLOWS —

1. (a) A manufacturer may, without special authority, deliver from his rice factory to a rice farmer every month one bag containing 180 lbs. of rice of any grade between Extra Super and No. 1.

(b) In cases where the household of the rice farmer exceeds six persons the rice farmer may request permission from the Authority to be supplied with an additional quantity of 30 lbs. of rice for every additional person per month.
2. A rice farmer would be eligible to receive the quantity of rice referred to in (a) only if he has delivered a quantity of padi to the manufacturer.
3. A manufacturer may, without special authority, deliver from his rice factory every month to himself for his own consumption the quantity and grade of rice referred to in paragraph 1 (a) and the provisions of paragraph 1 (b) shall apply where his household exceeds six persons.
4. The authority may, in addition to the quantities referred in clause 1, specially authorise a manufacturer to deliver from his rice factory to a rice farmer a specified quantity of rice of a specified grade for the rice farmer's own consumption if the Authority thinks that there is a special need by the rice farmer for such specified quantities.
