CREATION OF STATE MINING RESERVE

(Puruni River)

Notice is hereby given that the undermentioned area was, with effect from November 13, 1981, established as a State Mining Reserve:

“A tract of State Land consisting of a portion of the Puruni River, commencing at its mouth on the left bank of the Mazaruni River, thence upriver for 57 miles to a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile above Akwaparú River and including the bed and 100' inland from either bank and containing an area of approximately 2,957 acres save and except all lands lawfully occupied or held under title.”
