

## NOTICE

In accordance with section 2 (1) of the National Parks Commission Act 1977, after consultation with the Mayor and Town Council of New Amsterdam, I hereby declare the park known as The Esplanade Park and described in the Schedule as a designated park.

### SCHEDULE

#### Boundaries of The Esplanade Park

Being all that area of land situate at New Amsterdam in the county of Berbice and bounded as follows:

- On the North** by the southern limit of the New Amsterdam Abattoir compound and the prolongation thereof to its intersection on the east by the prolongation northward of the Esplanade road and on the west by mean high water mark of the Canje River.
- On the South** by the northern boundary of Lot No. "O" and its prolongation eastward to its intersection with the Strand and westward to Mean High Water mark of the Berbice River.
- On the East** — by the road known as the 'Esplanade' and its prolongation northward to its intersection with the southern limit of the New Amsterdam Abattoir compound and southward to the intersection with Strand, New Amsterdam.
- On the West** by Mean High Water mark, right bank of the Canje River.
