THE ROADS ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 277

WHEREAS by Sub-section 1 of Section 18 of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277 the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer has caused to be deposited at the Office of the Chief Engineer, Roads, Kingston, George town, in the County of Demerara, Notices accompanied by a plan showing the proposed construction and widening of the portions of the Public Roads in the Greater Georgetown Area —

- (a) From Kitty Avenue at Station 88 + 34.74 = Station 105 + 62.69 to the East Bank Public Road, Ruimveldt at Station 0 + 00, a distance of 1.673 miles; and
- (b) From Princes Street, Lodge Village at Station 146 + 65.00 to Ruimveldt Avenue at Station 105 + 62.69 a distance of 0.777 miles;

and has advertised the deposit of such Notices and the general purport thereof in the Official Gazette of the 12th, 19th and 26th May, 1973.

AND WHEREAS no objection to the proposed construction and widening of the portions of the roads aforesaid has been delivered to the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer in accordance with Sub-section 2 of the said section.

NOW THEREFORE, notice is hereby given that in accordance with Sub-section 3 of the said Section, the President in pursuance of the powers vested in him by such Sub-section and of all other powers enabling him thereunto, has determined that the said portions of the Public Roads abovementioned shall be constructed and widened to the extent proposed as aforesaid.
