

NOTICE TO IMPORTERS

In an effort to allow the Competent Authority to monitor the price of school books for students attending both primary and secondary schools, Government has decided to control the importation of school books. The Ministry of Education will advise on the importation of those books considered to be the basic requirement of students. The list of texts which cannot be imported by private agencies may be inspected at the Ministry of Trade and Consumer Protection.

2. Meanwhile, importers are requested to submit the following information to the Ministry of Trade and Consumer Protection, Main & Urquhart Street, Georgetown, not later than the 25th January, 1975.

The quantity and value of -

- (a) stocks of books on hand at 31st December, 1974;
 - (b) books for which orders have been confirmed but which up to the 31st December, 1974, have not been dispatched by the suppliers;
 - (c) books which on the 31st December, 1974 are either at or on the way to the docks for shipment;
 - (d) books shipped and not yet received as of 31st December, 1974.
- These returns must be supported by the relevant documents.
