## INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, (Chapter 5)

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL ON THE 20TH DAY OF MAY, 1967, DEPUTED THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS TO EXERCISE ON HIS BEHALF THE POWERS SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE TO THIS NOTICE CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY THE ORDINANCE MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATION:—

That the delegation of powers mentioned herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor-General.
