OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

WHEREAS under article 31 of the Constitution of Guyana it is provided that whenever the office of Governor-General is vacant or the holder of the office is absent from Guyana or is for any other reason unable to perform the functions of his office, those functions shall be performed by such person as Her Majesty may appoint or, if there is no such person in Guyana so appointed and able to perform those functions, by the Chancellor;

AND WHEREAS, His Excellency SIR DAVID JAMES GARDINER ROSE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General of Guyana will be absent from Guyana from Friday 24th February, 1967 to Wednesday the 1st March, 1967 and so will be unable to perform the functions of his office:

NOW THEREFORE be it known that SIR KENNETH STOBY, Chancellor, under and by virtue of the said article of the Constitution of Guyana, will assume the functions of the office of Governor-General during the said period, after taking and subscribing the oath of allegiance and the oath of office.
