

NOTICE

INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 5)

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR ON THE 26TH DAY OF APRIL, 1966, DEPUTED THE MINISTER FOR THE TIME BEING CHARGED WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SOCIAL ASSISTANCE DEPARTMENT TO EXERCISE ON HIS BEHALF THE POWERS SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE TO THIS NOTICE CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR BY THE ORDINANCE MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS :—

That the delegation of powers mentioned herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor.

2. The delegation of the powers mentioned herein to the Minister of Labour and Social Security on the 7th day of September, 1965, is revoked.

SCHEDULE

1. To appoint members of the Poor Law Commissioners.	Poor Relief Ordinance, Chapter 62. (Section 3(2)).
2. To terminate the appointment of any member of the Poor Law Commissioners in case of his absence from the Colony or for any other reason.	Poor Relief Ordinance, Chapter 62. (Section 3(4)).
3. To appoint a member of the Poor Law Commissioners to be chairman and any other member to be deputy chairman.	Poor Relief Ordinance, Chapter 62. (Section 3(5)).

7. To terminate the appointment of any member of a local board of guardians for absence from the Colony or for other reasons.	Poor Relief Ordinance, Chapter 62. (Section 13(5)).
8. To appoint members of the Adoption Board.	Adoption of Children Ordinance, 1955, No. 12 of 1955. (Section 3(1)).
9. To appoint the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman of the Adoption Board.	Adoption of Children Ordinance, 1955, No. 12 of 1955. (Section 3(3)).
10. To grant leave of absence to any member of the Adoption Board and to appoint any person to act in the place of any member of the Board in case of the absence or inability to act of such member.	Adoption of Children Ordinance, 1955, No. 12 of 1955. (Section 3(7)).
11. To revoke the appointment of any member of the Adoption Board.	Adoption of Children Ordinance, 1955, No. 12 of 1955. (Section 3(8)).
