

NOTICE**THE ROADS ORDINANCE**

(Cap. 277).

WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 18 of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer has caused to be deposited in the Roads Division of the Ministry of Works and Hydraulics, Georgetown and the District Engineer's Office, Atkinson Field, East Bank, Demerara River, in the County of Demerara, a Notice accompanied by plans of Project No. 44, Sections 1, (1A and 1B inclusive) 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the proposed new road and widening of the existing road, Soesdyke to Mackenzie *via* Atkinson, Demerara River and has advertised the deposit of such Notice and the general purport thereof in the Gazette of the 5th, 12th and 19th June, 1965;

AND WHEREAS every objection to the construction of the proposed new road and the widening of the existing road delivered to the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer has with his report thereon been transmitted by him to the Governor in accordance with subsection (3) of the said section:

NOW THEREFORE, notice is hereby given in accordance with subsection (3) of the said section that the Governor in pursuance of the powers vested in him by the said subsection and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf has determined that the said new road shall be constructed and that the said existing road shall be widened as proposed aforesaid.
