

NOTICE

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE

(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR DELEGATED WITH EFFECT FROM THE 9TH JANUARY, 1966, THE POWER SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE HEREUNDER CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR BY THE ORDINANCE MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE TO THE PERSON MENTIONED IN THE THIRD COLUMN THEREOF, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATION:—

That the delegation of the powers herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor.

2. The delegation of powers mentioned herein to the Chief Secretary on the 15th day of November, 1956, is revoked.

3. The delegation of powers mentioned herein to the Chief Secretary on the 21st day of July, 1959 is revoked.
