

## NOTICE

## THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1963

WHEREAS I am of opinion that it is necessary in order to maintain supplies and services essential to the life of the community to do work or to perform services for the purposes specified in the schedule hereto:

NOW THEREFORE, acting in accordance with article 22 of the Constitution of British Guiana and under the provisions of regulation 50 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1963, I do hereby authorise the Minister of Labour, Health and Housing to employ and pay volunteers or voluntary labour of any description for the purposes specified as aforesaid, and for the purposes of paragraph (3) of the said regulation.

## SCHEDULE

## PART I

For the purposes of:

- (a) public health and sanitation;
- (b) the movement and distribution of food, drugs and fuel specified in Part II of this schedule, and of such other forms of food, drugs and fuel as I may from time to time indicate in writing to the Minister of Labour, Health and Housing to be in my opinion essential to the life of the community;
- (c) land, sea and air transport; and
- (d) operating telegraph, telephone and postal services.

## PART II

- (a) the articles specified in the Schedule to the Emergency Powers (Maintenance of Supplies) Order, 1963;
- (b) the articles specified in the first schedule to the Emergency Powers (Regulation of Petroleum Products) Order, 1963.
