ORDER CLOSING AREA TO PROSPECTING AND MINING

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Section 32(1) of the Mining Act, Chapter 65:01, the undermentioned area of unoccupied State Lands is closed to prospecting, mining and locating of claims with effect from 9th October, 1978, until further notice —

A tract of State Land including the bed of the Mazaruni River commencing from the mouth of the Puruni River, thence up the Mazaruni River for a distance of about 154 miles to Fleming Island, also including the bed of the Puruni River from its mouth for a distance of about 57 miles up river, also including the bed of the Morabisi River from its mouth for a distance of about 22 miles up river, also including the bed of the Issano River from its mouth for a distance of about 16 miles up river, also including the bed of the Semang River from its mouth for a distance of about 34 miles up river, also including the bed of the Karanang River from its mouth for a distance of about 30 miles up river, also including the bed of the Merume River from its mouth for a distance of about 28 miles up river, also including the bed of the Rumong-Rumong River from its mouth for a distance of about 5 miles up river, also including the bed of the Eping River from its mouth for a distance of about 20 miles up river, also including the bed of the Perenong River from its mouth for a distance of about 14 miles up river, also including the bed of the Kurupung River from its mouth for a distance of about 27 miles up river, also including the bed of the Putareng River from its mouth for a distance of about 5 miles up river, also including the bed of the Meamu River from its mouth for a distance of about 15 miles up river, also including the bed of the Issineru River from its mouth for a distance of about 5 miles up river, and containing an area of about 25,747 acres save and except all lands lawfully held or occupied.

Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Order shall be guilty of an offence.
