BRITISH GUIANA.

NOTICE

Under the provisions of section 13 of the Poor Relief Ordinance, Chapter 62, the following district is hereby declared and established for the purposes of administration of relief to the destitute poor:—

The Rupununi Social Assistance District bounded as follows:—

- On the North — by the fourth parallel of north latitude from the boundary between British Guiana and Dutch Guiana to the watershed between the Essequibo and Berbice Rivers; by the watershed between the Essequibo and Berbice Rivers northwards from the fourth parallel of north latitude to the watershed between the Demerara and Berbice Rivers northwards to the fifth parallel of north latitude by the fifth parallel of north latitude from the watershed between the Demerara and Berbice Rivers to the boundary between British Guiana and Brazil;
- On the East by the boundary between British Guiana and Dutch Guiana southwards from the fourth parallel of north latitude;
- On the South by the boundary between British Guiana and Brazil;
- On the West by the boundary between British Guiana and Brazil southwards from the fifth parallel of north latitude,
