## NOTICE UNDER THE ROADS ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 277

WHEREAS by Section 18 (1) of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, the Director of Public Works has caused to be deposited in the office of the Public Works Department at Georgetown and Vreed-en-Hoop in the County of Demerara and in the offices of the District Commissioners at Bartica and Leguan and the District Engineer, Suddie in the County of Essequibo, a Notice accompanied by drawing No. RS 55/2 showing the alignment of the proposed road from Makouria to Urisirima and has advertised the deposit of such notice and the general purport thereof in the Gazette of the 10th, 17th, and 24th June, 1961, respectively.

AND WHEREAS no objection has been delivered to the Director of Public Works in accordance with Section 18 (2) of the said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, I do hereby give notice in accordance with Section 18 (3) of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, that I, by virtue of the power vested in me and by and with the advice of the Council of Ministers after due consideration, have determined that the abovementioned road shall be constructed and maintained out of moneys provided by the Legislature, and that all the provisions of the Roads Ordinance shall apply to this new line of road.
