

**NOTICE****INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,**

(Chapter 5 ).

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR DELEGATED WITH EFFECT FROM THE 30<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER, 1961, THE POWER SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN CONFERRED BY THE ORDINANCE MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN TO THE OFFICER MENTIONED IN THE THIRD COLUMN.
