BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1961

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY TO MINISTER

It is announced for general information that the Governor, in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (1) of article 33 of the Constitution of British Guiana, and acting in accordance with the advice of the Premier, has charged the Minister mentioned in the first column of the Schedule to this Notice with the responsibility for the matters or groups of matters set out against his name in the second column of that Schedule and with responsibility for the Departments of Government set out against his name in the third column of that Schedule, with effect from the sixteenth of June, 1962.

It is also announced that the Governor, acting as aforesaid and in accordance with the advice of the Premier, has designated the style by which the Minister shall be known as set out against his name in the fourth column of the Schedule.
