NOTICE

THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 61).

WHEREAS under section 3 of the Public Holidays Ordinance certain days are mentioned as public holidays;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 6 of the said Ordinance that the Governor may by notification in the Gazette appoint any day to be observed as a public holiday in addition to any day mentioned in section 3 of the said Ordinance and that thereupon the provisions of the said Ordinance shall apply to the added day:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers vested in me as mentioned aforesaid and acting in accordance with article 22 of the Constitution of British Guiana, I hereby appoint Saturday, the 27th of October, 1962, to be observed as a public holiday.
