

NOTICE UNDER THE ROADS ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 277

WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 18 of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, the Director of Public Works has caused to be deposited in the office of the Public Works Department, at Georgetown in the county of Demerara, a Notice accompanied by drawings Nos. RS 71, and R.S. 72 showing the proposed widening and deviation of the existing Public Road at Peter's Hall, Providence and Ramsburg on the East Bank of Demerara, and has advertised the deposit of such notice and the general purport thereof in the Gazette of the 14th, 21st and 28th April, 1962:

AND WHEREAS the single objection to the proposed widening and deviation of the said Public Road delivered to the Director of Public Works has with his report thereon been transmitted by him to the Governor in accordance with subsection (3) of the said section:

NOW THEREFORE, notice is hereby given in accordance with subsection (3) of the said section that the Governor in pursuance of the powers vested in him by such subsection and of all other powers him thereunto enabling has determined that the said road shall be widened and deviated as and to the extent proposed as aforesaid.
