UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR ON THE 3RD DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1962, DEPUTED THE MINISTER OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY TO EXERCISE ON HIS BEHALF THE POWERS SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE TO THIS NOTICE CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR BY THE ENACTMENTS MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING OUALIFICATION:—

That the delegation of powers mentioned herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor.
