NOTICE*under section 3.*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 3 of the Ordinance it is hereby declared by the Governor in Council that the Ordinance shall apply to the following timbers with effect as from 15th July, 1937 —

(1) When consigned to ports in the United Kingdom, Europe, Canada and the United States of America—

Sawn Greenheart.

Sawn Crabwood.

Sawn Mora.

Sawn Morabukea.

(2) When consigned to Barbados—

All barrel shooks or staves to any kind of timber.

Short title
and
application.

1. These rules may be cited as the Export of Timber Rules, and shall apply to such timbers as are for the time being timbers to which the Export of Timber Ordinance applies.

2. Certificates of export shall be issued in the forms lettered A and B as set out in the schedule to these regulations. Form A shall be used in respect of a certificate issued by an inspector who is an officer of the Forest Department or the Department of Lands and Mines and Form B in respect of a certificate issued by a person regularly engaged in the timber trade who is authorised to be an inspector under the provisions of the Export of Timber Ordinance. Form of export certificates.

3. These rules shall come into operation on 15th July, 1937. Date of coming into operation.
