AND WHEREAS section 5 of the said Ordinance provides that the Ordinance shall continue in force, up to and including the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one, but that the Legislative Council may, prior to the expiration of this Ordinance by resolution (which resolution shall be published in the Gazette) declare that it shall continue in force for a further period of one year from the date of expiration;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the said Ordinance should continue in operation for a further period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Medical Practitioners (Temporary Registration) Ordinance, 1947 (No. 24) shall continue in force for a further period of one year from the 1st of January, 1952.
