MOTION

1. The Minister of Finance to move the following motion:

WHEREAS Standing Orders Nos. 21(3), 35(2) and 61 of the Legislative Assembly prohibit the raising therein of any question substantially identical to any other question decided by the Assembly during the same session; and

WHEREAS an appropriation Bill for the year 1962 was defeated upon its third reading in the Legislative Assembly during the current session thereof; and

WHEREAS it is desirable that the Legislative Assembly should deal with an appropriation Bill for the year 1962 in the course of the remainder of the current session of the Assembly:

That this Legislative Assembly, in the exercise of the power conferred in that behalf by Standing Order No. 84 of the Assembly, hereby provides for the suspension of Standing Orders Nos. 21(3), 35(2) and 61 thereof so as to enable the Legislative Assembly to deal with an appropriation Bill for the year 1962, or any question affecting or connected with the Bill, in the course of the remainder of the current session of the Legislative Assembly.
