WHEREAS, Hurricane Ivan devastated Grenada in its rampage through the CARICOM Region;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Guyana joined with other CARICOM countries to pledge support to the people of Grenada;

AND WHEREAS, at an emergency meeting of the Conference of Heads of Government of the Caribbean Community, held in Trinidad and Tobago on September 15, 2004, the President of Guyana pledged the deployment of approximately 100 military personnel on a humanitarian mission for a period of about six (6) months.

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this Parliament honour the pledge of the Government of Guyana and approve the deployment of such personnel to Grenada for the purpose and period stated.
