- (i) Is the Minister informed of the high incidence of the offence of rape against women of Regions 8 and 9?
- (ii) If the answer is yes, is the Minister aware that Amerindian women are the main victims of these offences and that miners from across the border are main suspects?
- (iii) Further, is the Minister aware that in recent times the offence of rape is committed by persons who enter villages with vehicles and after violating females deprive communities of crops and animals?
- (iv) If the Minister has received information on this matter, will he say what action he intends to take thereon?
