ORDER

THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Chapter 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Brickdam, Georgetown) (No. 2) Order 1976* made on the 30th day of September, 1976, the building together with the land described in the Schedule to that Order was declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Act.

AND WHEREAS, by the said Order, the Chief Works Officer together with his agents, servants and workmen, was authorised under section 4 of the Act, to enter upon the said building and land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such building and land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or a part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer, together with a plan of the land and building to be acquired has been laid before the Minister.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the land described in the Schedule to this Order, together with the building and erections thereon, is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Brickdam, Georgetown) Order 1977.

SCHEDULE

All that parcel of land known as the North half of Lot number 26 (twenty-six) Brickdam and Pollard Place, Stabroek, situate in the city of Georgetown, Republic of Guyana, together with all buildings and erections thereon, surveyed and defined on a plan by A. N. Fagu, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 1st December, 1976, and recorded on 4th January, 1977, at the Department of Lands & Surveys, Georgetown, as Plan No. 17341.

The boundaries of the area surveyed commence at a concrete paal A.N.F., situate 28 feet west of the centre-line of Pollard Place and 55.60 feet south of the centre-line of Brickdam and extend thence $N76^{\circ}.02' W$ (tr.) to a wooden paal A.N.F., for a distance of 76.25 feet, thence $S14^{\circ}.58' W$ (tr.) to a wooden paal A.N.F., for a distance of 95.50 feet, thence $S76^{\circ}.02' E$ (tr.) to a wooden paal A.N.F., for a distance of 76.25 feet, thence $N14^{\circ}.58' E$ (tr.) for a distance of 95.50 feet to the point of commencement.

The said parcel of land contains an area of 0.1672 acre.
