(REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Remuneration of Holders) Order 2000.

Amendment of the Schedule to the Act. 2. The Schedule to the Act is hereby amended as follows -

(a) by increasing with effect from 1st January, 2000 the respective annual rates of salaries, as at 31st December, 1999 specified therein in respect of -

(i) the Judges of the Supreme Court of Judicature, the Ombudsman, the Director

of Public Prosecutions and the Auditor General, by twenty-six per cent;

- (ii) the Chairman and other members of the Public Service Commission, every appointed member of the Judicial Service Commission who is not a Judge of the Supreme Court of Judicature, every appointed member of the Police Service Commission and the Chairman and members of the Teaching Service Commission, by twenty-five per cent;

- (b) by the insertion of the following proviso thereto -


"Provided that the annual rate of salary with effect from 10th May, 2000, shall be the equivalent of -

- (i) sixty thousand United States dollars for the Chairman of the Elections Commission for

such time that office is held
by Mr. Joseph Govinda Singh
M.S.S.; and

(ii) six thousand United States
dollars for every other member
of the Elections Commission."
