IN THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988, AS APPLIED TO NATIONAL INDUSTRIAL & COMMERCIAL INVESTMENTS LTD. BY NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66 OF THAT ACT I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER: -

Citation and
commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the National Industrial and Commercial Investment Limited (Vesting of Property) Order 2000 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 18th July, 2000.

Interpretation.

2. In this Order-
 - (a) "NICIL" means National Industrial and Commercial Investments Limited, being a company incorporated in Guyana under the provisions of the Companies Act and continued under the Companies Act 1991 with registered office situated at 126 Barrack and Parade Streets, Kingston, Georgetown, Demerara.


