THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988

(No. 21 of 1988)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988, AS APPLIED TO THE NATIONAL PAINT COMPANY LIMITED BY NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66 OF THAT ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER —

1. This Order may be cited as the National Paint Company Limited (Vesting of Property) Order 1991.

Citation

2. In this Order "Company" means the National Paint Company Limited, being a company incorporated under the Companies Act and wholly owned by the State and to which section 5 of the Act has been made applicable with modification by the President by notification under the Act.

Interpretation.

Cap. 89:01

3. The immovable property of the State described in the Schedule, and which is at present in the possession of the Company, is hereby vested in the Company.
