| Citation and Commencement | 1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission (to conduct geological and geophysical survey Lithium, Tantalum, Niobium, Rare Earth Elements, Gemstones, Chromium, Nickel and Cobalt) Reservation Order 2018 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 1 day of 2018. |
| Reservation | 2. The area hereinafter described in the Schedule below is hereby reserved for prospecting operations by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto) for the benefit, wholly or partly, of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission. |

SCHEDULE

Tract of state land located in the Cuyuni Mining District No. 4 as shown on Terra Surveys Topographic Map 1 8NE, at scale 1:50,000 with reference point 'X' located at the confluence of the Waini River and the Arawapai River with geographical coordinates of Longitude 59°23'20.458 "W and Latitude 7°4'9.844"N

Thence at a true bearing of 323.12°, for a distance of 6 miles 585.197 yards, to the point of commencement:

Point A, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 59°26'40.027"W and latitude 7°08'33.749"N thence at true bearing of 118.22°, for a distance of approximately 38 miles 1447.78 yards, to Point B, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 58°56'44.218"W and latitude 6°52'37.286"N, thence at true bearing of 179.77°, for a distance of approximately 6 miles 1093.51 yards, to Point C, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 58°56'42.824"W and latitude 6°46'52.295"N, thence at true bearing of 270.00°, for a distance of approximately 22 miles 1137.66 yards, to Point D, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 59°16'31.084"W and latitude 6°46'47.129"N, thence at true bearing of 297.79°, for a distance of approximately 13 miles 10.3923 yards, to Point E, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 59°26'34.868"W and latitude 6°52'3.05"N, thence at true bearing of 360.00°, for a distance of approximately 19 miles 25.0842 yards, to the point of commencement at Point A

Thus enclosing an area of approximately 324,300 acres, save and except all lands lawfully held or occupied.
