ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958,  
(No. 33 of 1958).

UNDER THE PROVISO TO SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shops Hours (Special Provision) Order, 1966.

2. Every shop which is permitted by virtue of the approval of the Commissioner of Police to be opened and kept open on Fridays between the hours prescribed in the second proviso in Part I of the first schedule to the Shops (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1958, may be open during the following hours on Thursday the 3rd February, 1966, that is to say, 9.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
