ORDER  
MADE UNDER  
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE  
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1966.

2. Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended —

(a) by the addition of the following new item —

“71. Vinyl biscuits for use in the manufacture of phonograph records.”;

(b) in the manner set out in the schedule to this Order.

**SCHEDULE**

**Part III of the first schedule**

**Amendments**

Items 1, 2, 20, 30, 42 and 47

The words “of Scheduled Territory manufacture” shall be deleted.

Item 22 (2)

The words “of Scheduled Territory manufacture or production” shall be deleted.

Item 27

The substitution of the following for sub-item (14) —

“(14) Raw materials, containers, and parts of containers which the Comptroller is satisfied are imported for use in the manufacture of paints, varnishes, pigments, and painting products or for the packaging of such articles.”

Items 27 and 28

The words “when of Scheduled Territory origin or manufacture” shall be deleted.

Item 45

The words “of Scheduled Territory origin” shall be deleted.

Item 51

The words “of Scheduled Territory manufacture” shall be deleted.
