ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE GUYANA INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1966.

UNDER SECTION 5 (4) OF THE GUYANA INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1966 AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Independence (Adaptation and Modification of Laws) (Racial Hostility) Order, 1966, and shall come into operation on the 26th May, 1966.

Citation and commencement.

2. Regulation 4 (1) of the Racial Hostility Regulations, 1964, shall have effect as if it were enacted by Parliament pursuant to articles 60 (2) (d) (i) and 120 of the Constitution of Guyana and for the purpose shall be construed with any necessary adaptations and modifications and, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, as if for subparagraph (a) of regulation 4 (1) aforesaid there had been substituted the following —

Application of Regulation 4 (1) of the Racial Hostility Regulations, 1964.

“(a) election as a member of the National Assembly;”.
