

## BRITISH GUIANA

## ORDER

## MADE UNDER

THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE, 1962  
(No. 23 of 1962)

UNDER SECTION 34 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE, 1962,  
THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF  
MINISTERS —

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Industrial Development Corporation (Amendment) Order, 1966, and shall be construed and read with the Guyana Industrial Development Corporation Order, 1963\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.

2. Article 2 of the Principal Order is hereby amended —

(a) by the insertion therein of the words “until the twentieth day of May, 1966” immediately after the word “known” and the words “and thereafter as the Guyana Development Corporation” immediately after the word “Corporation”;

and

(b) by the substitution for the words “stimulate, facilitate and undertake the development of industry in British Guiana” of the words “stimulate and facilitate economic development in British Guiana”.

3. (1) The change of name effected by virtue of article 2 of this Order shall not affect any rights or obligations of the Corporation, or render defective any legal proceedings by or against it, and any legal proceedings that might have been continued or commenced against it by its former name may be continued or commenced against it by its new name.

(2) Any reference to the Guyana Industrial Development Corporation in any instrument or document of any kind shall be construed as a reference to the Guyana Development Corporation.
