THE OFFICIAL DESIGNATIONS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 57).

UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE OFFICIAL DESIGNATIONS ORDINANCE
AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS
ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY
THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Official Designations Order, 1967.
2. The schedule to the Official Designations Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution —
 - (a) in the first column, for the designations "Postmaster General" and "Deputy Postmaster General", of the designations "Director of Posts and Telecommunications" and "Deputy Director of Posts and Telecommunications", respectively;
 - (b) in the second column, for the designations "Director of Posts and Telecommunications" and "Postmaster General", of the designations "Postmaster General" and "Deputy Postmaster General", respectively.
