ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Powers Order, 1967.
2. The Attorney General and Minister of State is hereby deputed to exercise on behalf of the Governor-General the powers conferred on the Governor-General by Sections 9(3) and 19 of the Companies Ordinance, subject however to the following conditions and qualifications —
 - (a) that the delegation of the powers effected by this Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by the Governor-General;
 - (b) that the exercise of any power delegated by this Order shall be subject to any directions, either general or particular, which the Governor-General may from time to time give in that respect.
