THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Import and Export) Order, 1967, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1963*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.
2. The first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby further amended —
 - (a) by the insertion of the following items immediately after item 051—03 —
 - “ 051—04 Apples
 - 051—05 Grapes
 - 051—06 Figs (fresh), dates (fresh)”;
 - (b) by the insertion of the following items immediately after item 051—07 —
 - “ 052—01 Dates (dried)
 - 052—03 Tomato puree or paste”;
 - (c) by the insertion of the following against item 054—09 —
 - “carrots”;
 - (d) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 054—09 —
 - “ 055—02 Tomatoes, canned or in other air-tight containers, Peas and beans, canned or in other air-tight containers”;
 - (e) by the insertion of the following against item 292—06—
 - “ cuttings, trees, and plants, for use as Christmas trees”;

- (f) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 292—06 —
“ 292—07 Foliage for use as Christmas trees”;
- (g) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 899—02 —
“ 899—04 Artificial flowers”; and
- (h) by the insertion of the following against item 899—15—
“artificial Christmas trees”.
