THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,

(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1967, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1963*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order and all amendments thereto.

2. The first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby further amended—

(a) by the insertion of the following items immediately after item 641-05-

“642-01 Paper bags

642-03 Exercise books containing not more than eighty pages”;

(b) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 691—

“699-05 Wire fencing (chain link design)”;

(c) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 899-15-

“899-99 Mosquito coils”.
