THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 71)

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Johnson (Transfer of Insurance Policies) (No. 2) Order, 1967.
2. (1) It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the following four policies of insurance effected on the life of Eric Clinton Johnson in favour of the Financial Secretary in the sums of —
 - (a) one thousand two hundred dollars and seven hundred dollars, as assured with The Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society Ltd.; and
 - (b) six hundred dollars and one thousand dollars, as assured with The Barbados Mutual Life Assurance Society.
- (2) The Minister responsible for finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said Eric Clinton Johnson and his wife Laura Gertrude Johnson and pay over to them the proceeds of such policies of insurance and any increase thereon.
3. The Johnson (Transfer of Insurance Policies) Order, 1967, is hereby revoked.
